How Ancient Egypt was created

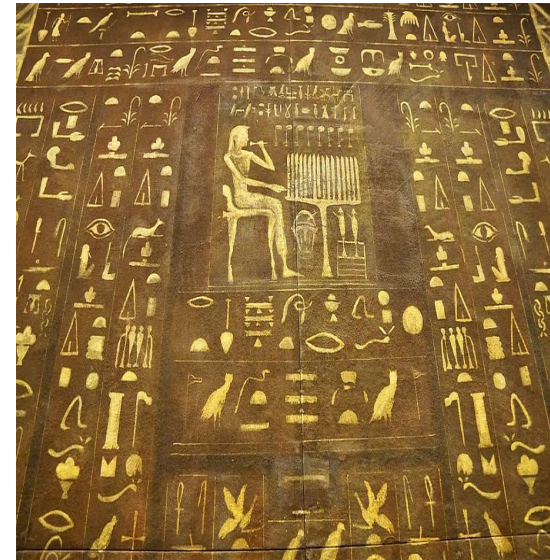
Ancient Egypt was a civilization of ancient North Africa which eventually developed along some parts of the Nile River which years later turned into the country of Egypt that we know today.

Ancient Egypt began itself between 3100-3150 BC and eventually became the first and preeminent civilization in the mediterranean world.



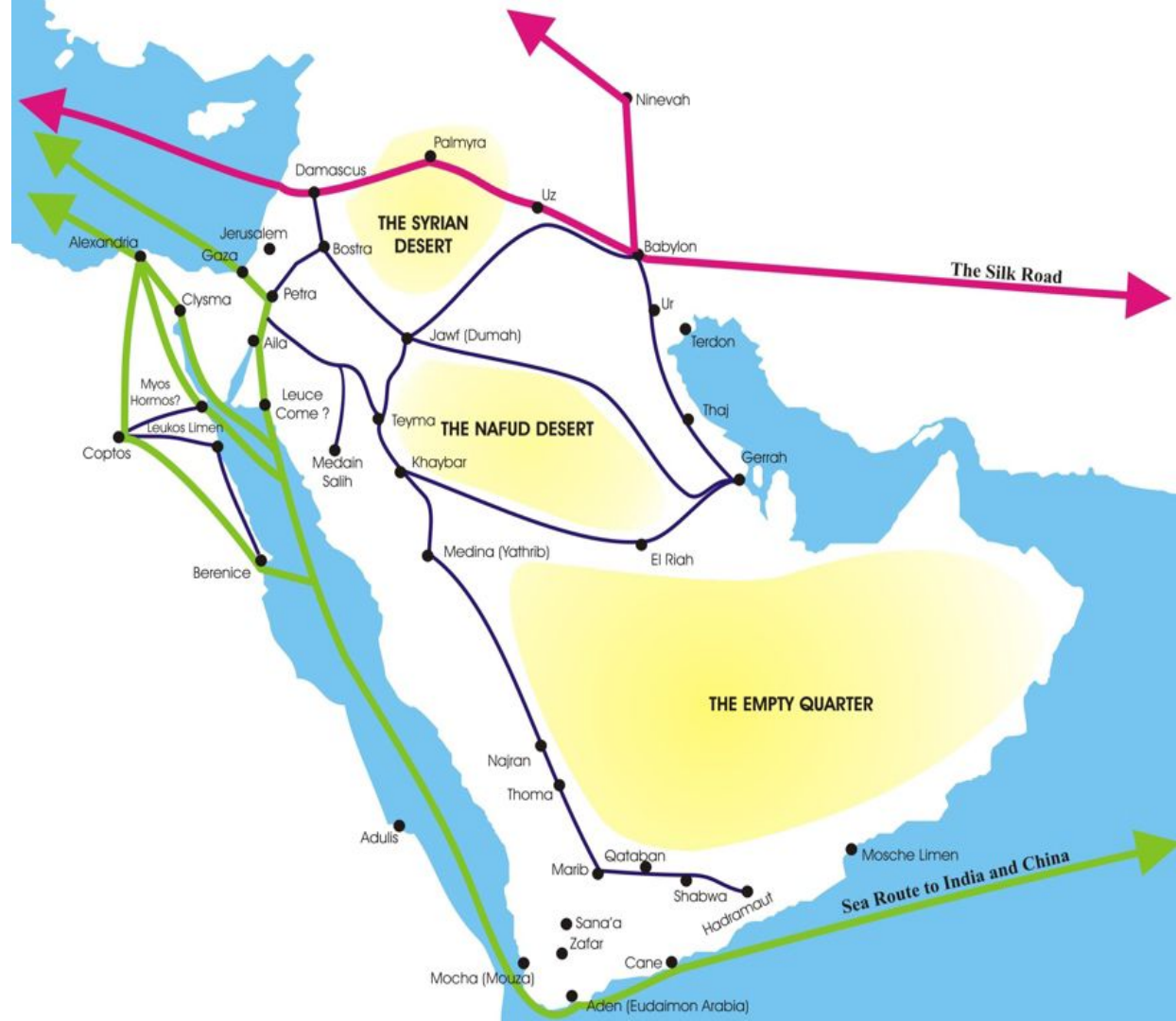
Accomplishments of Ancient Egypt

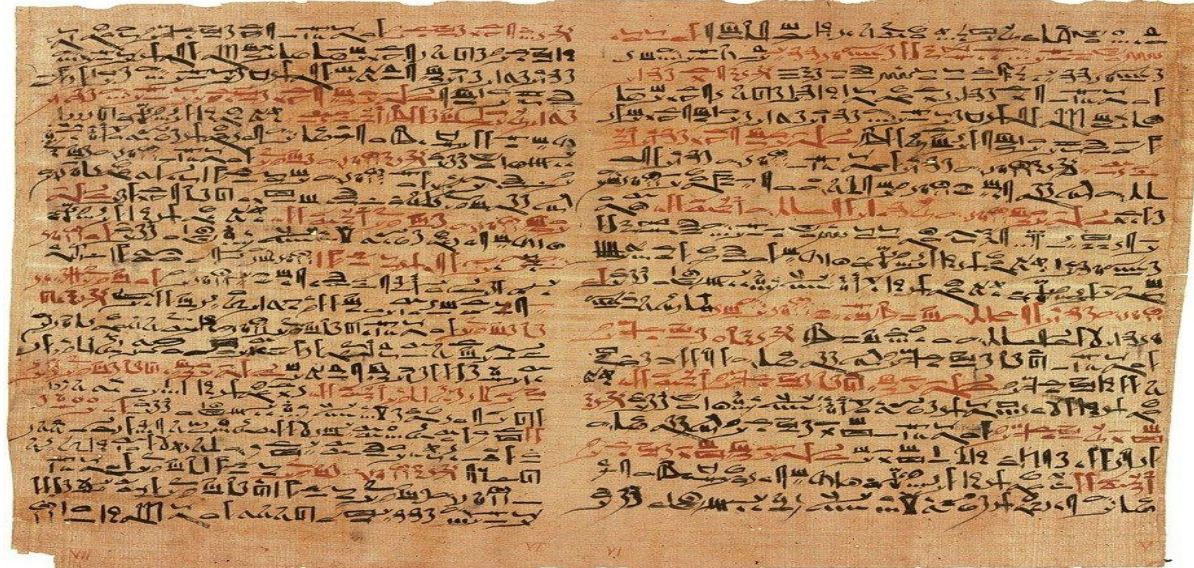
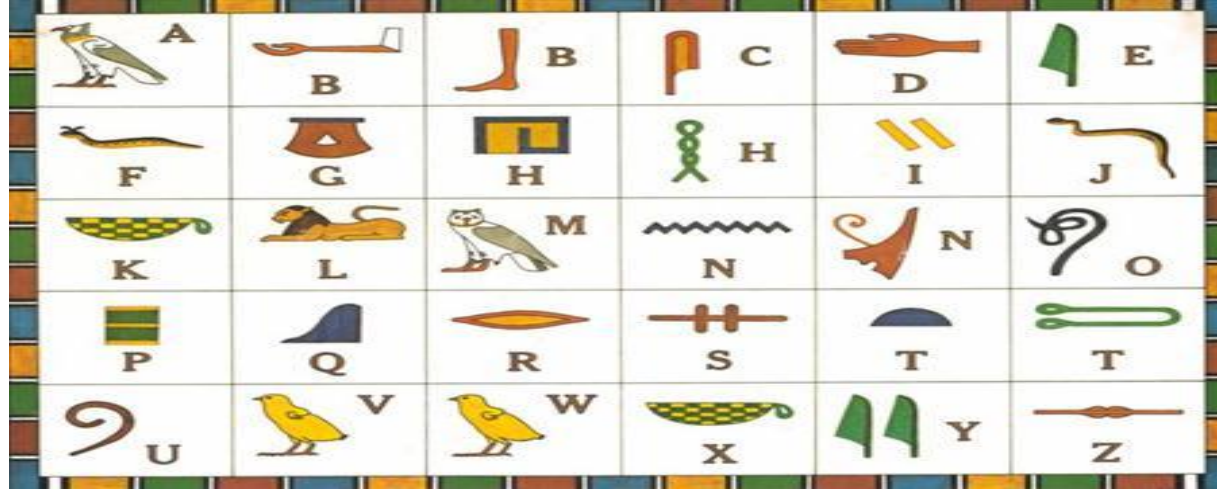
Trading in Ancient Egypt

Trading in Ancient Egypt was very important for the ancient Egyptians because that's how they would get their resources and foods in order for them to survive. For example, they traded with Anatolia for tin and copper to make bronze which is another civilization. They also traded with the Mediterranean which provided olive oil and more fine goods. Egypt exported grain, gold, linen and more fine goods. Trading helped the Ancient civilization become one of the wealthiest civilizations because of the many resources and goods they had there as well.



Hieroglyphics of Ancient Egypt

Ancient Hieroglyphics were written on papyrus and carved into the stone and tomb, temple walls and eventually used to decorate many objects of cultic and daily life use. In total there are about 700 different kinds of hieroglyphics, which are pronounced with only the sound and the syllables. They used these sounds and syllables as a language for themselves to be able to communicate with each other. They referred to their writing as “holy writing”. The tools that they used to make these symbols were hammers for stone and wood for smooth surfaces.



How they were able to become one of the wealthiest civilization

Ancient Egypt was able to become wealthy because of the access that they had being near the Nile River Valley, the river flooded their land so much that they realized that it would be fertile good crops such as flax, grains, vegetables, fruit and cattle. This made agriculture the source of Ancient Egypt's wealth.
