
#### **Ancient Kemet**

- People within Kemet were known to have paid taxes with the building of ariguculture produced this, and this became the foundation for Ancient Egypt's economy and government.




Ancient Kemet's Arts

 Most of Egyptian artists are unknown


 Most Egyptians artists were known to have based their artwork on functional, and most of the art were created for practical purposes

It was said that Ancient Kemet's development starting along the Nile River.






# Ancient Kemet's Religion

## Ancient Kemet's Artifacts



- It was a known fact that slaves had worn nothing when it came to them working out in the desert




# Ancient Kemet What the Egyptians Ate

- The presit and royalty were known to have eaten even better.




#### Ancient Kemet Burial Systems
